## **Our Mission**

## To develop, produce, and promote Latiné musical theater created by and for the Hispanic community in the U.S. and beyond. We aim to:

- Incubate and/or produce new musical theater works.
- Develop and support Latiné artists, creators & producers.
- · Provide pathways to commercial stages.

## Why Now?

- 93.6% of Broadway producers are white (AAPAC)
- · Only 4.3% are Latino men, 1.4% are Latina women
- For the first time, 2 Latiné-themed musicals were on Broadway at the same time after a 10-year hiatus: *Buena Vista Social Club* and *Real Women Have Curves*.
- · Buena Vista Social Club featured entire musical numbers sung in Spanish.
- · This is a historic turning point. We cannot stop here.

## Program 1: Service to the Field

#### **El Musical** strengthens the Latiné musical theater field by offering:

- Space Grants: Free rehearsal and performance space
- Seed Grants: Funding for script and score development.
- Workshops & Showcases: In-progress presentations with feedback.
- Marketing & Strategy Support: Consulting on branding, audience-building.
- Pitch Nights: Artist presentations to peers and potential supporters.
- **Punto SEA Hub:** An incubator space for open mics, new songs, scenes, and experimentation.
- Online Hub: Dedicated website & social media campaigns to spotlight Latiné creators past, present, and future.
- Creative Network: Access to mentors, collaborators, and resources.

**El Musical** is already in motion, developing the following original musical theater works:

#### **World Premiere**

#### Telenovela Dreams

A vibrant, comedic musical inspired by Latin American soap operas. This show pays homage to a pop culture staple, filled with over-the-top drama, romance, and fantasy, while delivering a heartfelt story about ambition, family, and identity.

#### ¡Deportado! Un cabaré sin retorno

A cabaret-style musical exploring themes of immigration, displacement, and exile. With a bold mix of satire, song, and storytelling, the piece gives voice to those caught in the inescapable tides of migration and borders.

#### Luna

A poetic and fantastical musical centered on the life, imagination, and inner conflicts of Federico García Lorca. The work blends historical truth with surreal theatricality, music, and the spirit of Lorca's own literary world.

#### Las mujeres de Casals

A bold original musical that tells the story of legendary cellist Pablo Casals through the voices of the women who loved him—his mother and four partners—gathered at his funeral in Puerto Rico. As they remember and celebrate him, they also confront their own stories, revealing the emotional, artistic, and societal challenges they faced.

#### **Divergentes**

A new LGBTQ+ musical set in Chile that follows seven characters as they experience the difficulties of love, friendship, loss, and chosen family. The show poses the great question: What would you do for love?


#### La Gloria: A Latin Cabaret




#### Los Monstruos
